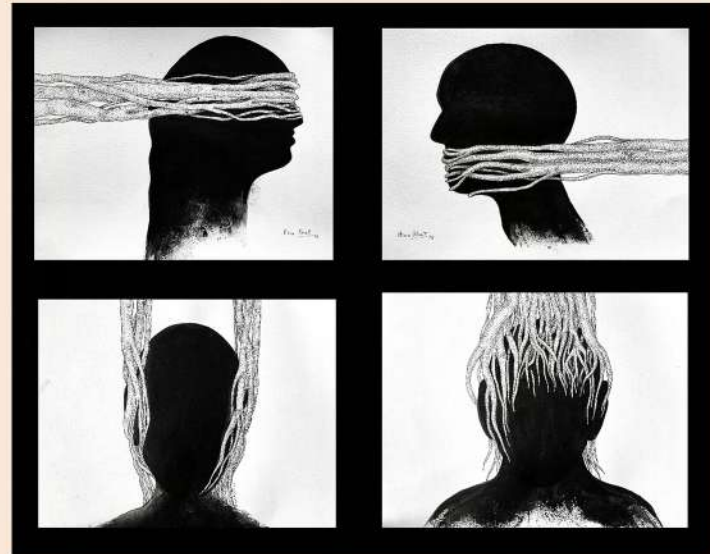




Hina Bhatt
