Her large digitally outputted images on paper amalgamate a myriad of processes including drawing - (digital and analogue), sculpture, scanned ephemera, and staged photography. Her work in installation is often accompanied by sculptural objects. Kidd was born in Edmonton, Alberta. She graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in Visual Communication Design from the University of Alberta in 1984, and a Master of Visual Arts with a specialization in Print Media from the University of Alberta in 1988. Kidd is currently an Associate Professor of Print Media at the University of the Fraser Valley in Abbotsford, British Columbia. In my digital series entitled "Underground mining" the photographic details are dominated by the geometric shapes, the combination of different forms, icons and symbols refers to the eclecticism of visual culture. At the center of my digital works, which are illustrated in a modern way, are the ordinary miners who stand out from the working class. The combination of monochrome photographs with red and yellow colors recalls the color pair characteristic of the early avant-garde. The photo detail depicting the miners takes on a whole new interpretation. The red and yellow are the colors of many signs and symbols used in the mining industry: raising awareness of the dangers. The mining world is different from the perspective of miners than from the perspective of outsiders. Every symbol has its own meaning and message. Geometric shapes often have a deep






